EMS ALERT 22-004: Pediatric Trauma Center Destination Update

The purpose of this EMS Alert is to advise EMS personnel about an update to the approved PEDIATRIC trauma center destinations for the UTSW/Parkland BioTel EMS System.

> Background:

- Medical City Children's Hospital has recently downgraded their Pediatric Trauma Center designation to Level III (from Level II).
- Only Level I or Level II Trauma Centers are approved transport destinations in the BioTel System for patients who meet the Prehospital Trauma Center Triage Criteria outlined in the Destination Decision-Making Policy.
- Previously, Medical City Children's Hospital was an approved transport destination for pediatric patients who met these Prehospital Trauma Center Triage Criteria.

> Effective Immediately:

- Medical City Children's Hospital (Medical City Dallas) is <u>no longer</u> an approved transport destination for pediatric patients who meet any of the Prehospital Trauma Center Triage Criteria outlined in the <u>Destination Decision-Making Policy</u>.
- Children's Medical Center Dallas is the ONLY approved Trauma Center for pediatric patients <u>younger than 14 years of age</u> who meet any of the Prehospital Trauma Center Triage Criteria.
- Refer to the Hospital Capabilities Matrix for a list of approved, designated Level I or Level
 II Trauma Centers capable of receiving patients 14 years of age or older.
